ORDER REQUIRING UNREDACTED DISTRIBUTION SCHEDULES TO BE PERMANENTLY FILED UNDER SEAL

By separate Order entered concurrently herewith, the Court has (1) granted Plaintiffs' July 20, 2017 Motion for Authorization to Distribute Net Settlement Fund; and (2) approved Defendant Wells Fargo Bank's July 20, 2017 Application for Entry of Previously Collected Funds Distribution Order. As part of their respective filings, and to protect Class Members' privacy, Class Counsel and Wells Fargo each submitted redacted versions of their proposed distribution schedules. These redacted filings list only the initials of those Class Members to whom distribution checks will be mailed, and include no full names or other personally identifiable information of such Class Members.

Class Counsel and Wells Fargo have now each delivered unredacted versions of their respective distribution schedules to the Court for inspection, and the Court has approved such schedules in their entirety. Class Counsel and Wells Fargo have requested, and this Court agrees, that the unredacted versions of the distribution schedules should be permanently retained in the Court's file under seal so as to continue to protect the privacy interests of individual Class Members. Accordingly, Class Counsel and Wells Fargo are hereby ordered to file their

respective unreducted distribution schedules with the Court in sealed envelopes, where they will remain permanently under seal unless and until this Court orders otherwise, and only for good cause shown.
